- 2 Ask them directly to join the European Alzheimer's Alliance made up of MEP's from across Europe.

There are close to 8 million people with dementia in Europe. 48,000 people live with dementia in Ireland (Ref: *Cahill et al*, 2013) and there are 50,000 family carers. Dementia is an umbrella term used to describe a range of conditions which cause changes to the brain. It has significant physical, psychological, social and economic implications.
