Early Career Researcher Travel Bursaries



Background

The Alzheimer Society of Ireland and Dementia Research Network Ireland are hosting a half-day **Research Knowledge Exchange Seminar** on February 22nd, 2023.

This event will bring together people living with dementia, informal carers/supporters, healthcare professionals and researchers to share knowledge and build capacity for translating research findings into real life. The event is for early career researchers, people living with dementia, clinicians, experts in the dementia field and carers / supporters in attendance.

This event will take place in The Radisson Blu Royal Hotel (Golden Lane) in Dublin 22nd February 2023, running approximately 9:30am to 2pm.

Bursaries

A small number of travel bursaries are available to early career researchers whose research is focused on dementia (across all disciplines and areas of work).

Eligibility

Applicants must:

 Be a current postgraduate student (L9 Masters or L10 Doctoral) in a relevant area during 2022/2023 in a Higher Education Institution in the Republic of Ireland.

Funding

Travel costs that can be covered under this travel bursary include:

- Public Transport (including rail & bus)
- Accomodation

Travel will need to be booked by The Alzheimer Society of Ireland on behalf of the recipients so please outline, where relevant, specific costings and provide detailed information on time / dates for bookings. Please include links where appropriate. Only expenses that are reasonable and fair will be considered and and rationale must be given as part of the application.

Conditions

- All bookings of accommodation & travel (rail / train) will be booked through The ASI on behalf of the recipient.
- It is the responsibility of each recipient to ensure they provide the most up to date information and costings to The ASI.
- The ASI does not retain any responsibility for changes to hotels / public travel that are out of our control.
- Where there are any additional charges incurred due to changes etc., this will be covered by the recipient.

Application Review

Please note that bursaries will be selected at random from eligible applications and not subject to a formal peer review process.
