

## Daycare at Home Worker - Clare and Limerick Regions

The ASI is currently recruiting a Care Worker who will work for our Clare Daycare at Home Services and Limerick Daycare at Home Services. The successful candidate will work in assigned family homes across Limerick and Clare and regions.

This is a permanent contract of employment working 20 hours per week – 10 hours per week for Clare Daycare at Home services and 10 hours per week for Limerick Daycare at Home services.

The successful candidate will be responsible for providing social activity-based care with minimum personal care. This can include music sessions, reminiscence therapy, arts & crafts, gentle exercises, conversation, companionship and recreational activities.

They would also provide person centered care to people with dementia in the client's own home. You will need good communication and organizational skills and be able to work on your own initiative.

To be successful in this position it is essential you possess previous experience of undertaking social and cognitive stimulation activates with people with dementia, older people or people with intellectual disabilities.

Candidates in this area must have a full clean driving license and access to a car to be considered for this role. Confidence in using IT/Email is also desirable. We are offering a competitive salary commensurate with the care sector, and dependent on relevant experience.

The role holder must strictly adhere to all National Guidelines laid out in QSPD guidance and be always COVID aware. Training in PPE / Infection Control and other relevant areas will be provided by The ASI prior to the role holder entering a client's home.
