Bursaries

As part of our research strategy to drive research investment, ASI is offering five bursaries to Early Career Researchers to cover registration fees for the conference. This is to support the next generation of researchers in Ireland to share their work on an international stage, build lasting networks, and learn the newest updates in dementia research.

Eligibility

Applicants must:

- Be a current postgraduate student (Masters or Doctoral) in a relevant area in a Higher Education Institution in the Republic of Ireland.

Funding Conditions

- The bursaries are available to cover **Conference Registration Fees only**.
- Recipients must be prepared to arrange and cover the cost of their own transportation and accommodation if required, through alternative means.
- If you are successful, The Alzheimer Society of Ireland will register you for the conference directly.
- No funds will be transferred to recipients.
- This bursary is non-transferable and cannot be exchanged for monetary value.

- Financial Need as outlined in the application form.
- Submission/Planned Submission of an Abstract. (Deadline for abstract submission is 30 April)
